Having been diagnosed with an incurable, stage IV, highly aggressive cancer at age 27, Caroline is an expert in the importance of holding onto hope, even in the darkest of times. After completing eight rounds of chemo, Caroline went into a brief remission before her cancer reappeared for the second time. In 2006, Caroline bravely chose the risky option of a bone marrow transplant and relied on her brother's donor stem cells to save her life. After six months, Caroline emerged from this transplant cancer-free.

Due to the lasting effects from the intense chemo used to save her life, Caroline was told fertility was no longer an option. Unwilling to take no for an answer, Caroline and her new husband persevered, still determined to start a family. Within eight months of her transplant, she was pregnant with her daughter via IVF, and one year later, had a miraculous natural pregnancy with her son. Five weeks after Caroline's son was born, she discovered her cancer was back for the third time. Now that Caroline was a mother to a two-year-old and five-week-old, the game had changed. Caroline was NOT going to let this cancer take her away from her children.

Caroline's second bone marrow transplant was the hardest and riskiest treatment she had faced. With a 40% mortality rate, Caroline didn't know if she would ever see her children again. This brave mother's story is one of determination, perseverance, love, and- above all else—hope.
