Stage

• The stage must be well lit – Duane must be visible to all audience members. General lighting might mustifice, and spotlights would be needed.

Sound

- Headset Mic
- 1 Handheld/cordless Microphone
- Professional Sound System (Speakers and sound desk with inputs for the two microphones as well as the laptop/CD Player)
- Sound Technician to be present
- 60 Minute Sound check

Visual

For audiences larger than 250 people a camera feed to screen must be supplied.

Room Set-Up

- The stage should be viewed as the main feature and not background entertainment
- For the stage, the audience must be seated in such a way to make the stage visible to everyone or sufficient screens.
- The Stage should be in front of the audience and not in the middle.
- **Décor** Please be mindful of big arrangements on tables. It prevents tables at the back from seeing the stage.
- **Dancefloor** Having a large dancefloor between the stage and the audience creates a distance between the Emcee/Speakers and the audience. Not only can it hinder visibility for people at **t**e back, but the performances can also lose its intimacy and interaction. Please consider smaller dance floors or move the dancefloor to the back of the room.
